NOTICE - THE FORESTRY ACT REGULATIONS

1 - No person shall cut more than two acres of forest land or more than twenty cords of pulpwood or pit props in any calendar year without first having obtained a permit from the Minister. 2 - Persons requiring a permit to cut more than two acres of forest land in any calendar year must file an application with the Forestry Division, Department of Industry and Natural Resources stating: (a) The area proposed to cut; (b) Total area of woodland. 3 - Any person buying or shipping pulpwood or pit props in the Province must obtain a license from the Department and pay therefor a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00). The above regulations are effective as from September 10, 1951. Permits and Licenses may be obtained by applying to: Department of Industry & Natural Resources, P. O. Box 251, Charlottetown, P. E. I.

Grain

WINNIPEG, Sept. 11 - (CP) - Grain prices showed a strong tone today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange on buying influenced by continued unfavorable weather across the prairie harvest belt. The nearby contracts displayed the firmest tone, with offerings light. The other months moved up in sympathy with the advance. Export loadings of the Canadian wheat totalled about 3,100,000 bushels in the last two days, with 1,100,000 bushels going to the Netherlands, 900,000 to the United Kingdom, 500,000 to Belgium, 350,000 to Japan, 150,000 to Switzerland, and 130,000 to the Republic of Ireland. Other reports said eight cargoes of Canadian wheat, involving about 2,700,000 bushels, had been sold to Japan. Class two wheat and I.W.A. prices were unchanged from yesterday.
