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ALONE IN MID-OCEAN.

The L'Orionne Brings News of Capt. Gardner and His Crew.

Captain Stansfeld, commanding the British tank steamer L'Orionne, which has just arrived from Dartmouth in the last, brings tidings of having fallen in with the 14-foot dory, flying Dutchman, which was seen on the Atlantic, on July 23, in latitude 42.44, longitude 46.36, which is about 1100 miles off the coast.

The dory was a vessel of 12 tons, built in England, and was under the command of a man named Gardner, who was accompanied by 12 men.

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INCESSANT TALKERS.

Americans in European Society. Europeans recognize no social or class distinction in this country. Our people know that this is a republic, that it has been a republic for more than a century.

There should be any kind of class distinction or gradations of society. In their eyes all Americans are equal, and the question as to what constitutes a citizen in this country weighs but very little with the grand general in Europe. It is utterly immaterial to them whether their American acquaintance has ever had a grandfather or not, or if he had, who his grandfather was.

But once an American has succeeded in getting himself accepted by the best European society his position is one of the most delightful one, since he is regarded as beyond the pale of class distinction and is considered a free citizen of the world.

The Face That Attracts. A clever Boston author, with whom Ario Bates talked about the whimsical festival, to which all the world went in costume of the time of the renaissance, remarked that it was impossible to get over the habit of looking at the faces of the persons present rather than at their costumes.

It is simply because we are so accustomed to living in the costume, and especially the costume of men, so uninteresting that we never think of looking at it. "I am not sure," the author returned, "that it does not go a good deal deeper than that, and that there is not a profound psychological reason for it. The Soldiers' Pace in Marching. Colonel Hutton reminds us that the marching value of the army is that of the best of the world, and that of its best, for we cannot afford to out-march our worst regiments and thus deplete their numbers. The rate of marching laid down in the infantry drill, 1892—that is, 120 paces of 30 inches per minute—gives a rate of 3 miles 720 yards per hour, including the five minutes' halt, 3 miles 220 yards per 55 minutes.

The Largest Salmon. An enormous salmon was caught in the River of the Sound at London, a few days ago, the largest seen for 20 years. It was a male, and was captured in the bay. When put in the scales it turned out to be 48 pounds. The measurements were: Length, 53 inches; girth, 30 inches. The largest salmon on record is known as the King of the Scots, which weighed nearly 70 pounds.
