NOTICE UNDER MUNICIPALITIES EXTENSION ACT

I, John J. Butler, City Clerk of the City of Charlottetown, do hereby, in accordance with the provisions of the Municipalities Extension Act, give notice that the By-law to include an Area of the former School District of Spring Park within the Corporate Limits of the City of Charlottetown which was given first and second readings by the City Council of Charlottetown on September 10th 1962 and a certified copy of which is published herewith, will be considered by the City Council of the said City after the expiration of thirty days from the date of posting as required by sub-section (2) of Section 3 of the said Act, and that the Mayor of the said City has fixed Wednesday the 24th day of October 1962 as the day and date on which the required plebiscite is to be held.

BY-LAW TO INCLUDE AN AREA OF THE FORMER SCHOOL DISTRICT OF SPRING PARK WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTETOWN

WHEREAS it is deemed to be of advantage to the Citizens of the City of Charlottetown as well as to the residents of the District of Spring Park to extend the limits of the said City to include the area hereinafter defined so that economy and efficiency of essential services, hereinafter defined, and water supply, may be had by co-operation of operation and extension.

AND WHEREAS the final and effective passing of this By-law is intended to be conditioned upon the approval as required by the Municipal Extension Act of the residents of the area intended to be included.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:—

1. THAT from and after the passing of this By-law the corporate limits of the City of Charlottetown shall be extended and extended to include the area comprising that portion of the former school district of Spring Park which was not included within the limits of the village of Spring Park as heretofore taken into the corporate limits of the City of Charlottetown, that said area is described as follows:

COMMENCING at a point where the North boundary of the City of Charlottetown is intersected by the Canadian National Railway right-of-way; thence Westward along the North boundary of the City of Charlottetown to the shore of the North End Bay; thence Northward along the East shore of the North River and Ellen's Creek to Hermitage Creek so marked on Mechenam's Atlas; thence Eastward along the said last mentioned Creek and the South boundary of James Sumner's land to the Kingshore Road; thence Northward along said road to the South boundary of Robert Wigmore's land; thence Eastward along Wigmore's South line to the Western side of the Canadian National Railway right-of-way, and thence Southward following the Canadian National Railway to the point of commencement.

2. That upon the approval and final enactment of this by-law such area shall constitute an addition to and be part of Ward Six of the said City.

3. That the said City will immediately make available or provide school accommodation for the area.

4. That the City will provide police and fire protection for the area.

5. That the City will provide street maintenance for the area.

6. That the City will proceed to design and install water service for the area to provide such service within five years from the final enactment of this by-law, and if necessary by the City augmenting the funds of the Commissioners of Sewers and Water Supply.

7. That the City will provide sewerage service for the area at such time in its discretion as sewerage service shall appear practicable and necessary.

8. That the valuation of real property in the area assessed for the year 1957-1958 in the Spring Park school district as improved property shall remain unchanged for the years 1961, 1962, 1963, 1964,
