# Millions Are Hailing Eisenhower On His Goodwill Journey To Asia

Summary of the week: President Eisenhower was hailed by millions on his visit to Asia. At the United Nations, Canada asked Hungary about reports of new reprisals for the 1956 revolt. The worst storms in 20 years hit Europe.

**TRIUMPHAL JOURNEY**  
The enthusiasm of Eisenhower's welcome in Turkey, Pakistan and India was described in such words as stupendous, tumultuous, colossal.

Some Indian villagers thought he was a reincarnation of Vishnu, the protector in the Hindu trinity. One old Hindu woman said that like Vishnu, he held the power to destroy the world and was at the same time a great benefactor.

"Did he not send us wheat when we needed it and build us dams?" she asked.

The need to conquer hunger—"the sort of war that dignifies and exalts human beings"—was mentioned in a speech by the president Friday. He called on all nations to help achieve a world free from hunger.

At a session of the Indian Parliament Thursday he said the U.S. has forces ready to help its friends who perceive the dangers of aggression from "an alien philosophy backed by great military might."

In a call for international peace, Eisenhower said that "controlled universal disarmament is the imperative of our time."

**APPEAL TO HUNGARY**  
The United Nations' General Assembly renewed its appeal to Russia and Hungary Wednesday to end their repression of anti-Communist Hungarians. Few diplomats believed a mildly worded resolution deploring the Communists' "continued disregard" of UN resolutions on the 1956 uprising and its aftermath would have much effect.

On Tuesday, the Canadian delegate, Wallace B. Nesbitt, said there is "reason to believe that new and shocking events may have taken place in recent months." He referred to reports that teen-agers involved in the unsuccessful revolt had been held for execution until they reached the age of 16.

External Affairs Minister Howard Green said in Ottawa that Canada hoped the publicity would help stop the executions. It was a "calculated risk" that Canada's stand at the UN might increase world tension, he added.

**HAPPY FAMILIES**  
The Archbishop of Canterbury, Dr. Geoffrey Fisher, says it takes at least three children to make a family.

"One, child," he said at a prison church dedication ceremony in England Monday, "is just miserable all by itself. Two children just fight each other but with three you have got an arbitration court. Three of them can talk it out."

**UNIVERSITY AID PLAN**  
The government has agreed to a plan for federal aid to universities proposed by Quebec Premier Paul Sauve. Provided Parliament approves, it will take effect in April.

Since 1952, Quebec universities had refused federal aid because of the late Premier Maurice Duplessis' disapproval.

Sauve's government suggested that Quebec be allowed to increase its corporation income tax by one per cent to 10 per cent. The extra money will help to provide funds for provincial universities on the same scale as the federal university grants program.

**STORM'S TOLL**  
Not since February, 1936, when more than 200 died had the North Atlantic and Europe known such storms. More than 100 perished on land and at sea in the last six days. Seven ships were known to have gone down and more were missing.

A Portuguese tug and its tow capsize, a Greek ferryboat turned turtle on a lake and many North Sea fishing vessels were wrecked.

A large part of Warsaw's water supply was frozen for a time. Italian fruit crops were damaged, parts of southern England were flooded, gale-driven snow blanketed Sweden and there were fears of a second flood at Frejus in the south of France.

**GETTING ATTENTION**  
One hundred Montreal cab-drivers, angered by a police ban on cruising for fares, drove to Mayor Sarto Fournier's home at 2 a.m. Tuesday and leaned on their horns until the mayor came outside. Fournier quieted them by saying the city would look into the cruising ban.

**WORRIED BY DELAY**  
Prime Minister Diefenbaker told a television audience Thursday night he was disappointed that the East-West summit conference will not be held this fall.

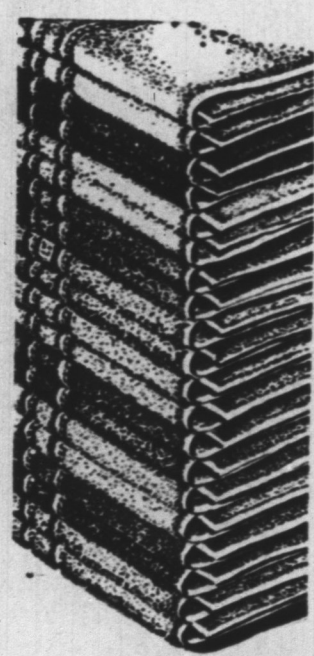
