TO HOLD ATOM TALKS

LONDON (Reuters)—The government announced plans Tuesday for a meeting of Commonwealth nuclear scientists to discuss co-operation in the peaceful development of atomic energy. The conference would be held in September, 1958, immediately after a United Nations atomic energy conference in Geneva. No site was announced for the talks, which were suggested at a meeting of Commonwealth premiers in London earlier this month.
