original trustees of Parkdale when this school district was formed. He resigned when the district decided on a two-room school for the 81 children in place of a four-room school as planned by the original trustees. Later, he again was appointed a trustee and saw the two-room school develop to an eight-room school.

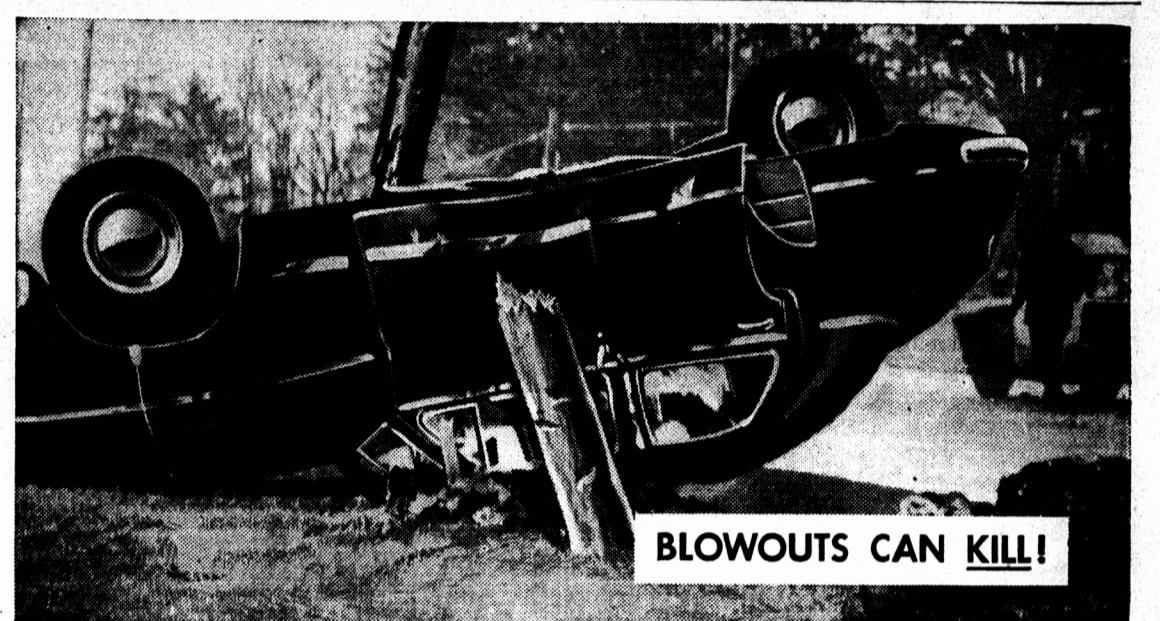
Notes Educational Progress

He was one of the original trustees when the Department of Education decided to form a unit, taking in seven schools, and have them supervised by one set of trustees. This necessitated the building of five new school houses comprising twelve class rooms. These, Mr. Driscoll feels, are the most modern type of schools and a credit to the district and Department.

Being interested in youth, he became Scoutmaster of the 6th Charlottetown Troop, and when World War Two broke out he joined the Reserve Army. He received his commission in the Cadet Services becoming a part time instructor for the Army Cadets in Charlottetown, a post he held until the Cadets were again attached to the schools in 1945.

Continuing his association with the Boy Scouts, Mr. Driscoll was recently appointed Provincial Commissioner for the youth movement here.

Commenting on his retirement, Mr. Driscoll stated the generality of men on retiring pass from activity to a secluded life, but he feels that in taking on the post of Commissioner in the Scouts he can continue to contribute something worthwhile to Scouting help to mould the character of youth and teaches them the responsibilities of citizenship.
