# Canadian Cadet Still Missing

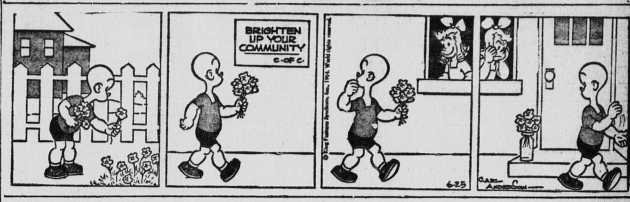
