

# Flags of Convenience" Rouse Ire Of Big Shipping Company

MONTREAL (CP)—Shipping companies using "flags of convenience" have roused the ire of the Angus Cunnard Line. Col. Denis H. Bates, chairman of Cunnard Steamships Co. Ltd., raised the matter in his annual report to stockholders.

This led shipping sources here to review the situation, which has resulted in Liberian and Panamanian and other "flags of convenience" appearing in increasing frequency. Liberia is emerging now as one of the most "convenient" countries, these sources say.

Liberia, which at the end of the Second World War had no shipping to speak of, now has a gross tonnage of 3,997,000 registered under its flag, exceeded only by the tonnage registered to the United States, Britain and Norway.

Chief value of flags of convenience is that owners escape the taxation to which they would otherwise be liable under the flags their native countries.

Emphasizing this point, Col. Bates declared that companies with ships registered under flags of convenience thrive in almost total avoidance of taxation-but in a perfectly legal manner.

Had Cunnard been registered under a flag of convenience, he added, the company's profits would have been an additional 5,000,000. The problem of providing ships at current high prices would thus have been largely solved.

Many of Canada's post-war deep sea vessels have been placed under foreign flags because of high cost of operation, including taxation, under the Canadian ensign, sources here recalled.
