Meanwhile Ballem's teammates slugged away at Joe Thistle and Ed Murphy for 14 safe hits. Jack Kane was the big batter for the Lions sending five runs scampering across the plate with a pair of doubles and a single.

In tonight's tussle it will be the BJS Shamrocks at home to the Dodgers, who are looking for their first victory in 13 starts.
