NEW YORK
NEW YORK (AP) — The stock market Wednesday made an inauspicious 1963 debut, posting losses in the popular market indicators as trading sank to the lowest level since the semi-annual Columbus Day. Oct. 12, 1952.
A livelier performance had been expected Wednesday due to anticipated retirement of large sums reaped from year-end dividends and tax-loss sales. Volume fell to 2,540,000 shares from Monday's year-end total of 3,430,000.
Caution was linked by brokers to several factors. Some market advisers suggested prices might backtrack a bit in order to digest the victorious November rally.
Secondly, President Kennedy was reported seeking a gradual tax cut, thus dampening the enthusiasm of some who hoped for swift dramatic action in the president's power tax-cut ally, Senator Robert S. Kerr, was construed as throwing extra doubt over the legislative fate of whatever tax cut proposals the administration makes.

SOME TAKE PROFITS
Some of the price weakness was ascribed to profit-taking by those who had gained a number of stocks and wanted to record those profits at the outset for 1963 tax returns.
"Practically everybody has profits on Jersey Standard and General Motors," said one broker.
Standard Oil (New Jersey) ended the day with a 1/2% gain, but GM, after easing at the start, closed with a net gain of 1/4%.

STEELS, NOURISHED BY PREDICTIONS
Prices of big January shipments, after falls, hopeful of additional merger approval by the government, advanced against the trend of most blue chips.
The Associated Press average of 60 stocks fell 7/8 to 242 1/2. Hudson Bay Mining gained 1/4, among Canadian stocks. Canadian Pacific and Aluminum Ltd. were up 1/4. Walker-Good, etham lost 1/4 and Distillers Seapine 1/4.

Prices on the American Stock Exchange were mixed. Shawinigan was active and off 1/4 as profits were taken. Quebec Power rose 3/4. Security Rainbow Oil fell 1/4. What stocks did:
