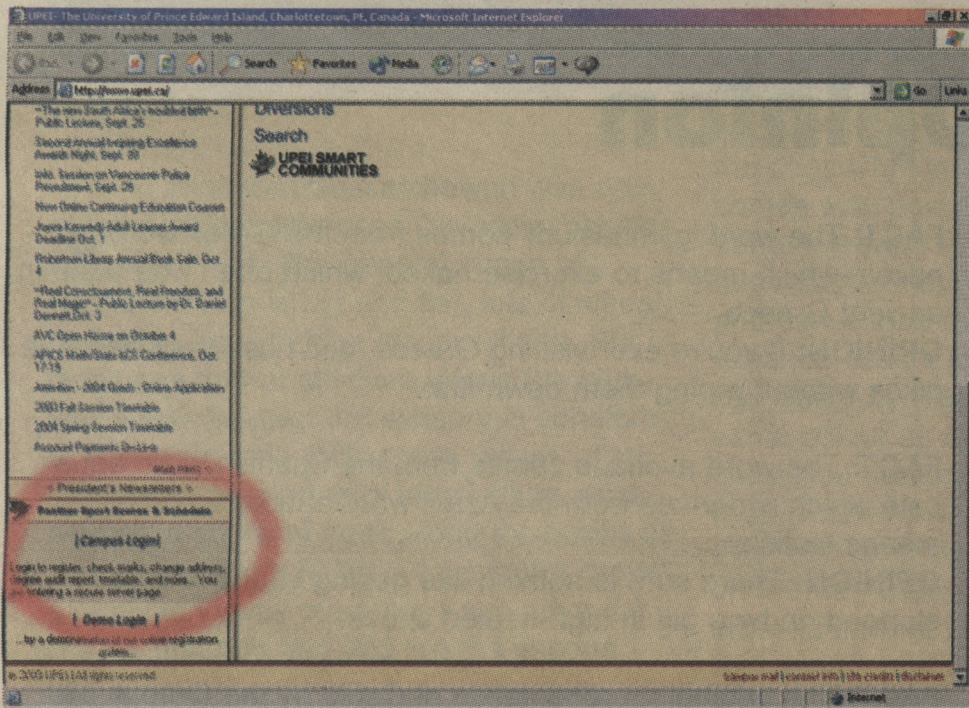


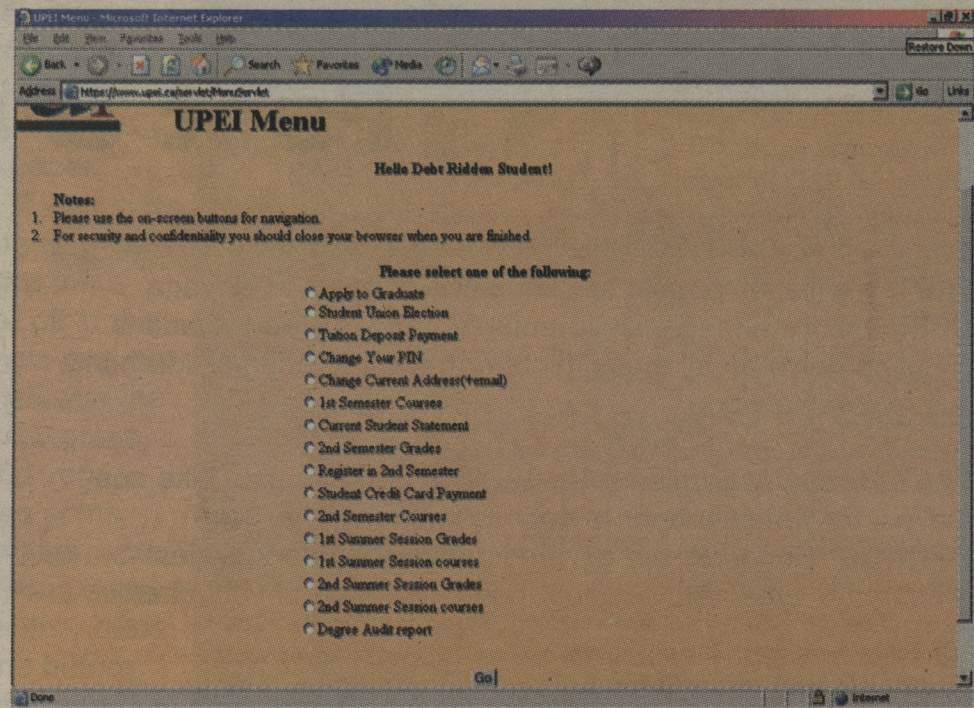
Your Guide to On-Line Voting



Beginning at 8:00am on Wednesday, October 1st, UPEI Students will be able to cast their vote in the Student Union elections from the comfort of home or anywhere else they have access to the Internet. Union elections will now be handled Online through your UPEI Campus Login.

Developed in response to students' concerns, the 2003 WebVote aims to provide all students with an opportunity to partic-

ipate in the decision process. "By creating the Online system, our Student Union has dramatically increased the potential access for students by using the excellent technology available campus wide", expressed Brandon MacKenzie, Student Union President. "We all recognized the need for change surrounding our electoral system and the new WebVote is a collaboration of all our collective efforts."



To participate in the WebVote, students must log on with their student number and PIN through UPEI's Campus Login. Next Students must choose the Student Union Elections option in their account. Finally, to vote Students must select each ballot and cast their choices.

To give students plenty of time to cast their votes, the election period will begin on October 1st from 8:00am until 11:30pm and

will re-open on October 2nd between 8:00am and 9:00pm.

"Several other universities in the Atlantic Provinces have switched to online voting and report a significant increase in voter turnout," SU Vice President Finance Jared Hogg said. "For our students, the new system offers an even larger window for voting aimed at attacking the apathy which has been known to plague our election process."
