Inco slid 1/4 to 81. Great West Life dropped 3/4 to 52 1/2, Massey-Ferguson 1/2 to 21 after touching a low of 20 1/2 and Alcan 1/2 to 27.

Trans-Canada's jump was spurred by a government announcement Tuesday night that it would allow the company to build part of its proposed East-West pipeline through the United States.

MONTREAL (CP) - The market continued to slide lower in light trading Wednesday on the Montreal Stock Exchange. The industrial index dipped 0.48 to a low of 137.81.

The estimates of Canada's gross national product, the price index of 30 industrial materials, and new orders for durable goods all point to an economic slowdown.

Among senior mines, Noranda sank to 47 1/2, off 1/2, and International Nickel 5 1/2 to 8 1/4.
Dormar and MacMillan-Bloedel lost 1/2 at 16 1/2 and 24 1/2 respectively among papers.

Trans-Canada Pipe Lines ended up .04 at 104.77.
Brinco on 34,878 shares finished 1/2 lower at 5 1/4.
BANKS IMPROVE
Banks ended higher with Royal gaining one point at 64 1/2 and Canadian Imperial Commerce 1/2 at 53 1/2.

On the Canadian Stock Exchange, West Hill Copper on 92, 150 shares, ended off 10 cents at 71 cents. Midexa Industries Ltd. dropped 15 cents to a new low of \$3.00.

The composite index hit a low, off 0.27 at 132.34. Papers were off 0.54 at 105.25; utilities unchanged at 125.95; and banks were up 0.66 at 104.13.
