Glanders in London.

LONDON, Oct. 13.—It is reported that a case of glanders has been found in a horse landed from Montreal is now subject of inquiry by Canadian officials here. The report creates uneasiness among those who know the readiness with which the British Board of Agriculture would shut down on the competition with British farmers.

Sherman's Reply.

LONDON, Oct. 13.—Before finally ordering out all the organized trades in sympathy with the striking British engineers a conference has been called with the employers. The latter now deny that they intended to try and crush the unions.

OTTAWA, Oct. 13.—Collingwood Schriber is back from an official inspection of the Crow's Nest Pass railway. First 110 miles of the line will be finished this season. Three thousand hands will be employed in the construction, and 500 teams.

True Bill Against Davidson.

ANTIGONISH, Oct. 13.—The Supreme Court opened yesterday, Chief Justice McDonald presiding. The grand jury found a "true bill" against Davidson for the murder of Bowman at the Tracadie picnic.

Atrocious Murderer Captured.

PARIS, Oct. 13.—Vatcher, the author of many mysterious murders in France has been arrested at Lyons. He imitated "Jack the Ripper," and killed and mutilated a number of women.

LATEST NEWS BY WIRE AND MAIL.

LONDON, Oct. 11.—In reply to a petition signed by sixty-four members of the Irish party in the house of commons, asking the government to call a special session of parliament to deal with the exceptional distress in Ireland, Arthur J. Balfour, first Lord of the treasury, has written to John Dillon as follows: "The government has observed the partial failure of the potato crop with great concern, and is watching anxiously the condition of the people in the threatened district. There is no need however, to summon parliament earlier than is customary, because, should the apprehensions of the memorialists be unhappily realized, the executive is empowered to take such action as may be necessary."

NOTES AND COMMENTS.

—The Canadian Monthly remarks that Dr. Bourinot, like some of our virile thinkers, is not wholly satisfied with the manner in which our educational system works out:

"The animating principle with the majority of people is to make a young man a doctor, a lawyer, an engineer, or to teach him some other vocation as soon as possible, and the tendency is to consider any education that does not immediately effect this result as superfluous."

The child is given too many subjects to study, so that he is not taught much of anything. We have plenty of education, but few learned men. Even-manners are omitted from the educational preparation for money getting. Superficially expresses the sum and substance of our educational weakness, and Dr. Bourinot has done well to point this out.
