

P.W. Of Canada Reports Exceptionally Busy Year

An exceptional year of activity on the Island by the members of Public Works of Canada is reported by Mr. Clive Currie, district engineer, in his bi-monthly report.

Reconstruction of Victoria's wharf which was started in 1953 has now been completed. In this instance the existing wharf which was built of untreated lumber has been completely replaced by steel framing and now has a gravel surface. It is hoped that at some future date the surface of the wharf will be paved.

The wharf is 225 feet long and 57 feet wide along the water side and 14 feet high. It will accommodate ships with a draught of 14 feet. The height of the wharf from the top to the surface of the water at low tide is 32 feet.

The wharf has three small warehouses. The improvement in the wharf will greatly facilitate traffic both from a hauling basis and from a sea going point of view. Several barges have been loading at Victoria this fall. It has been pointed out that Victoria has a long narrow wharf and would have to be dredged before ships of larger draught could come in.

The contractor for the job is J. H. Anderson of Burnaby, B.C. Local inspectors were James MacLeod and George Cannon.

POINT PRISM
Built from an extension has been built 240 feet long and 20 feet wide. This construction is composed of steel framing and concrete cribs filled with rock and joined by 300 ft piles.

The timber crib method of construction is becoming fairly popular because of their economy and their ability to withstand heavy waves action. Also built at Point Prism is a rubble mound breakwater 200 feet west of the wharf.

Quite a number of fishermen in the area will enjoy the benefits of the wharf in Point Prim.

FRENCH RIVER
A fisherman's landing wharf has been completed at French River. This structure is 300 feet long and is constructed of treated piles with a concrete deck. A clay fill behind the deck provides storage space for traps and other fishing gear.

At New London Bay 3,500 feet sand collection cribs have been placed to strengthen sand dune protection. The gradual filling of the dunes will allow the water from the lake to have several inches which will be effective in the draught of the main harbour mouth. Engineers say that by closing off the same inlet the water is forced to flow in and out through a smaller channel, thus insuring a more rapid turnover.

A crew has been working all day at similar work at Brackley shore placing sand collection cribs where last year several barges were damaged. This is part of an overall scheme to make Rustico harbour a safer anchorage for the boats of the boats to enter or leave. It is reported that since the closing of the harbour the depth of Rustico is considerably greater. Little Harbour was made on a fisherman's wharf at Horton. This wharf when completed will be 100 feet long.

POVERTY BEACH
At Poverty Beach in the 400 foot retaining wall and a 600 foot landing is nearing completion. A breaker built 200 feet parallel to the landing has been completed.

The 11 piles used in its construction have been driven at an angle so as to form an A. In the addition to the breaker a hardwood surface provides fendering from the ice.

Considerable difficulties have been experienced in the construction of this wharf and breaker by the contractor Morrison and MacFarlane. During the winter the action of the ice took away a great portion of the work which is now being completed on the coastlines.

Boats 30 and 40 boats fish from this area. Their work in the past has been done without protection from the sea and the new landing and breaker will suit greatly to the operation.

WRECKERS PAID
The wharf at Souris has been saved on the north side of the wharf approaches, the west end and the southern part. Asphalt has been used.

On this 8,000 yard surface of paving the traffic now goes to the wharf on the north side and returns on the south side. Modern lighting has been installed consisting of five steel standards.

Death Of Well Known Resident Of Montague
The death of A.D. MacLeod, a well known and highly respected citizen of Montague, occurred at his home yesterday afternoon following an illness of six years.

His last home was at Murray Harbour North on February 26th, 1887, son of the late Carney D. MacLeod and his wife Margaret (Dixon) MacLeod. He was associated with the Montague Furnishing Co. Ltd. for many years until he retired in 1933 because of ill health.
