By The Canadian Press TORONTO, (CP) - Prices were mixed on Monday's quiet stock market session. Western oils were ahead at the close although they lost some of their forenoon strength. Canadian Devonian was the feature. It added 55 cents. Gridoil, Canadian Prospect and several others were also strong.

Base metals edged forward with seniors strong. Juniors and Manitowadge-area issues slipped a little. Uranium and Bathurst - area base metals showed one of their lightest sessions of the month as all traded issues moved only slightly. Golds were lightly traded. Seniors were slightly stronger. Juniors and holding companies were a little lower. Bralorne reached a new high - \$4.25. Closing indexes showed golds up .06 at 71.36, base metals up 12 at 144.3 and western oils down 25 at 98.17.

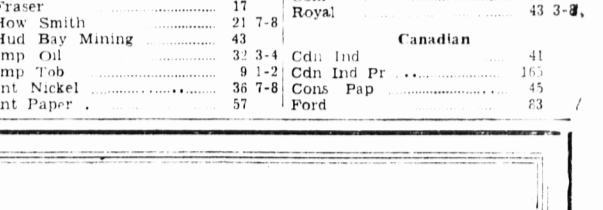

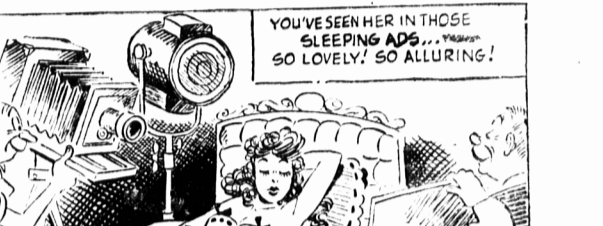
