NEW YORK (AP) - Some stock market averages made new highs Monday. Strong buying pushed up various blue chips as well as an array of speculative favorites.

The Dow Jones industrial average advanced 8.34 to 938.88, coming close to its historic closing highs of 939.62 made on May 14.

Record closing highs were made by The Associated Press average of 60 stocks and by Standard and Poor's 500-stock index.

The AP average rose 2.9 to its record close of 346.1, topping the 344.7 made last May 6.

Standard and Poor's index rose 6.3 to 90.65, bettering the 90.27 made May 13.

Sperry Rand, breaking out to a new high at 16, was the most active stock, keeping a net gain of 1/2 to close at 15 1/2.

SCM Corp., which rose more than 10 points last week, soared 6 points to 47 1/2.

Among Canadian issues, International Nickel advanced 1/2. Down 1/2 were Dome Mines and McIntyre Porcupine. Off 1/4 were Hudson Bay Mining and Walk-Over-Gooderham.

Prices rose irregularly on the American stock exchange. Brazilian Tractor and Canadian Marconi went up 1/4. Molybdenite lost 1/2.

MONTREAL: MONTREAL (CP) - Stocks were generally higher in moderately active trade Monday on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges.

Industrial volume was 131,000 shares and mines and oils 1,483,300. The composite index rose 0.25 to 157.20.

Industrials were up 0.31 at 162.44. Moore Corp. added 1/2 to 74.

Papers climbed 0.63 to 124.14. MacMillan, Bloedel and Powell River added 1/2 to 30 and Abitibi 1/2 to 11 1/2.

Banks were up 0.13 at 125.49. Nova Scotia added 1/4 to 74 1/4 and Montreal 1/4 to 61 1/4. Imperial Commerce dropped 1/4 to 65 1/4.

Utilities were up 0.09 at 153.56. CPR added 1/2 to 67 1/2. Calgary Power 1/4 to 26 1/4 and Brinco 1/4 to 6 1/2.

Senior oils were lower with Pacific Petroleum dropping 1/4 to 10 1/4. Primary metals were also off with Algoma dropping 1/4 to 64 1/2. Canada Iron added 1/4 to 55.

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
