**New Mining Town Only Position And Hope Now**

CHIBOUGAMAU, Que., March 8—(CP)—This town, for the moment, hasn't a thing except geographical position and hope. Fly over it and all you can see are survey lines cut through the forest on the shores of Gilman Lake. But it lies at the end of a \$4,000,000 road cut 195 miles through virgin forest north from Roberval, Que., by the Quebec Government. And Premier Maurice Duplessis has prophesied "fantastic development" for the Chibougamau gold and copper country.

Over this road mining companies bent on exploitation of a new and remote land midway between the St. Lawrence and James Bay have been trucking drilling equipment this winter. By spring lots in the townsite should be open to auction.

"Then you will see Chibougamau grow," says Ed L'Italien, 51-year-old employee of the Quebec Smelting and Refining Company who has been here 15-odd years hunting minerals and staking claims. The townsite was mapped and surveyed by the government even before any contracts were let and that was in 1946 — for the road to link it with the outside world.

**Grain**

WINNIPEG, March 8—(CP)—Coarse grains continued their upward trend in moderately active trade today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, with fair demand, mostly from shippers, in both oats and barley.

Barley also came in for purchases by processors. Moderate offerings were well taken and prices closed at or near the highs of the day.

Rye was mostly local trade, with some commission house demand noted early in the session in response to upturns on American markets. Light offerings, however, were the main factor in the advance. Flax trade was dull.

In the only export business reported, Israel purchased a small cargo of Canadian wheat.

Class two wheat prices advanced one cent from yesterday.
