# Martin Expresses Regret To Sud-Aviation Company

OTTAWA (CP) — External Affairs Minister Paul Martin expressed his regrets to the government of France that the controversy over its Caravelle jetliner grew to such proportions.

Trans-Canada Air Lines chose the Douglas DC-9 over the Caravelle as its new medium-range jet despite objections by Quebec supporters of the French plane.

Mr. Martin was replying to a question by Louis-Joseph Pigeon (PC — Kollette - l'Assomption-Montcalm) about his activities on a recent trip to Paris.

The external affairs minister said he had not met Gen. Paoli, president of Sud-Aviation, but had spoken over the telephone to the company's director-general.

"I explained," Mr. Martin said in French, "that the decision of TCA was determined by the particular needs of the airline and I expressed the regrets of the Canadian government that the incident took such proportions."

He added that even if their respective interests were affected by the incident, relations between the Canadian and French governments were not concerned.

Leon Balcer (PC-Trois-Rivieres) then asked Mr. Martin what he thought about a newspaper article by Douglas Fisher (NDP—Port Arthur) who wrote that the attitude of Raymond Bosquet, French ambassador to Canada, was not very diplomatic in the Caravelle incident.

Mr. Martin replied he had not read Mr. Fisher's article

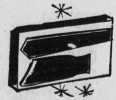
