

UPEI STUDENTS TO EUROPE

Three UPEI students have been selected by the Canadian Association of University Teachers of German, CAUTG, to take part in their "Workstudent Program 1980" and a fourth student was chosen for the reserve list.

Katalin Schmidt [not the Marxist-Leninist], William Pound, and Stella Wallace will be leaving at the end of May for Germany and will return at the end of August. Réjean Côté is on the reserve list. Their exact placements in Germany have not been determined yet, but in recent years UPEI

students have been placed in various romantic towns and cities in Bavaria, usually along the Danube near the Black Forest and

the Swiss Alps.

CAUTG works in collaboration with the Canadian government, the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), and the Central Manpower Office in Germany (ZAV). The trip to Germany is subsidized and costs the student only \$340 for the round trip. Necessary transportation in Canada is subsidized by the Canadian government.

All of the students are

required to work for at least eight weeks and then they are free to travel for a month on the money they saved during their employment. Before beginning employment, they have the option of taking a low cost tour

of Germany. Most of the students will be doing semi-skilled jobs such as working in hotels and restaurants. If the employer does not provide room and board, he will be willing to assist the student in securing adequate accommodations.

Approximately 200 students go on the "Workstudent Program" every year.



Requirements for participation are:

a) Canadian student at a Canadian post-secondary institution.

b) A working knowledge of German - at least one year of university German.

c) 18 - 30 years of age.

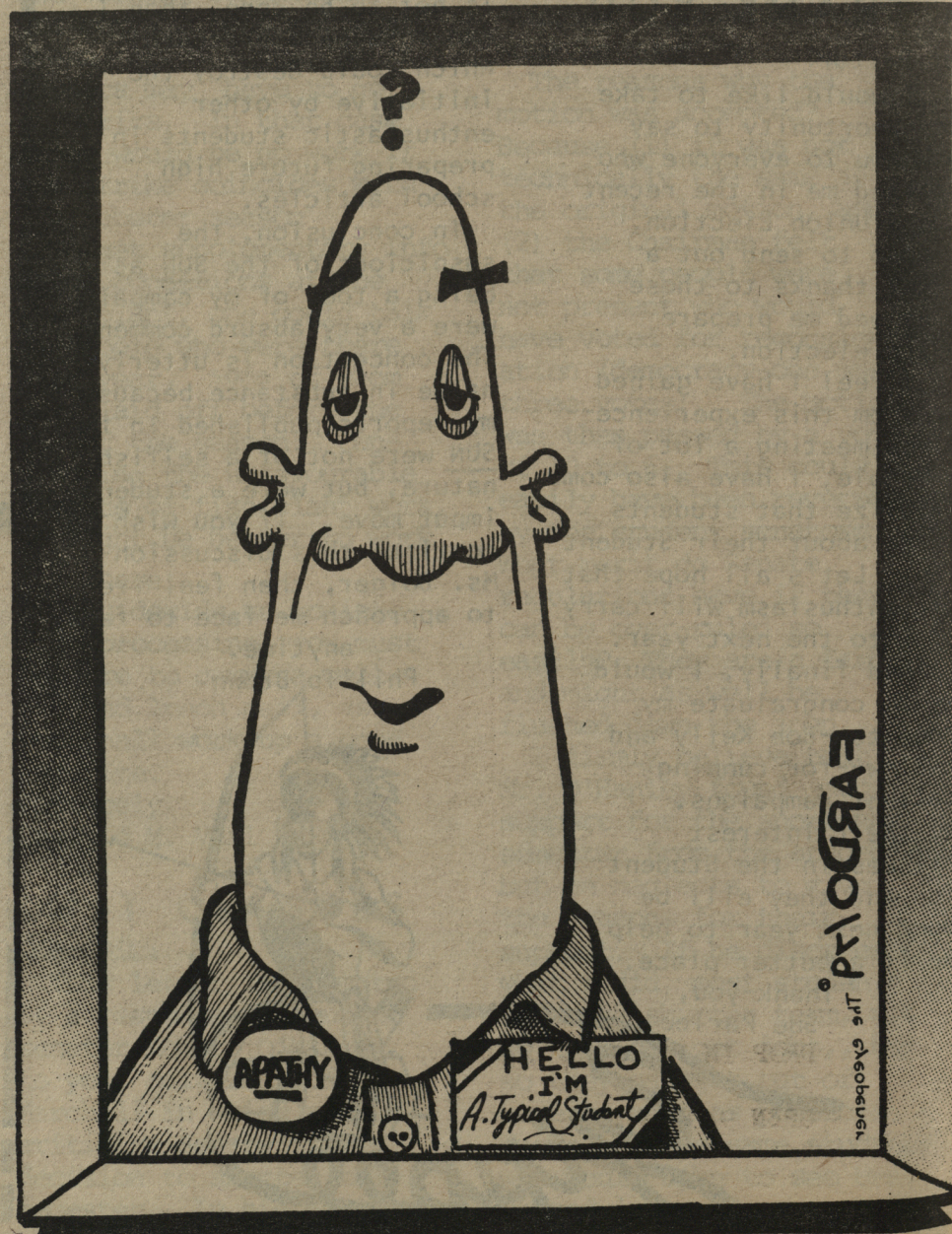
