**LATEST WAR NEWS.**

**RETREATING BOERS.**

LONDON, March 24.—Five thousand Boers with 16 guns, on retreat along the Basutoland border, are in imminent danger of being hemmed in and meeting the same fate as Cronje's army.

It is believed that a force especially despatched by Lord Roberts is chasing them, and that General French will head them off.

News of the fleeing burghers who are making their way northward from Norval's point and Bethulie for the purpose of eluding Lord Roberts and joining the Boers at Kroonstad, has been received from different points in their progress.

Yesterday General French was reported to have located them south-eastward of Bloemfontein.

To-day word comes from Springfontein that they were in retreat north of Smithfield, and the mounted scouts are harassing them. It is believed at Springfontein that the column sent out by Lord Roberts from Bloemfontein will be able to catch up with them and round them up with the help of General French.
