Avocados Can Be Served In Many Different Ways

Luncheon at the lovely old Pierpont Inn, overlooking the vast Pacific, was a delightful treat in our tour of the lush lemon and avocado groves in Ventura County, California.

"What is a literal translation of the Mexican word 'guacamole'?" I asked our host, John Shepherd. "It originated from the fact that it is always served heaped up in little heaps," he replied.

Guacamole: Peel, pit and crush 2 ripe avocados. Add 1 minced peeled tomato, 2 tsp. minced onion, 1/2 a mashed canned green chili and 2 tsp. lemon juice or mild cider vinegar. Mix and add salt to taste. Refrigerate. Serve within an hour.
