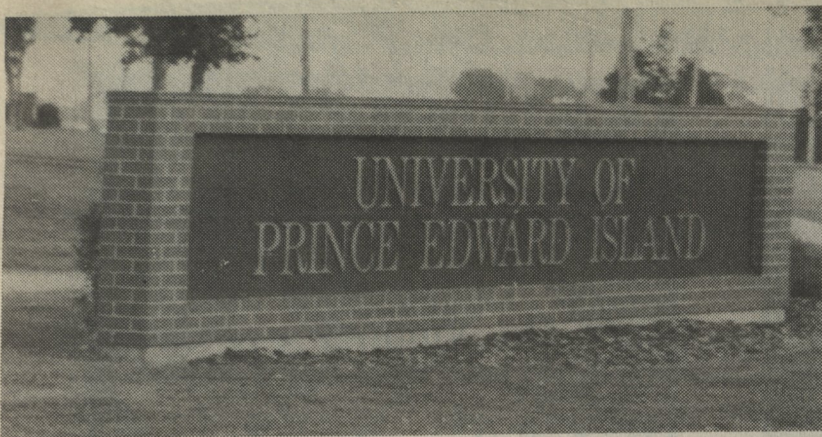

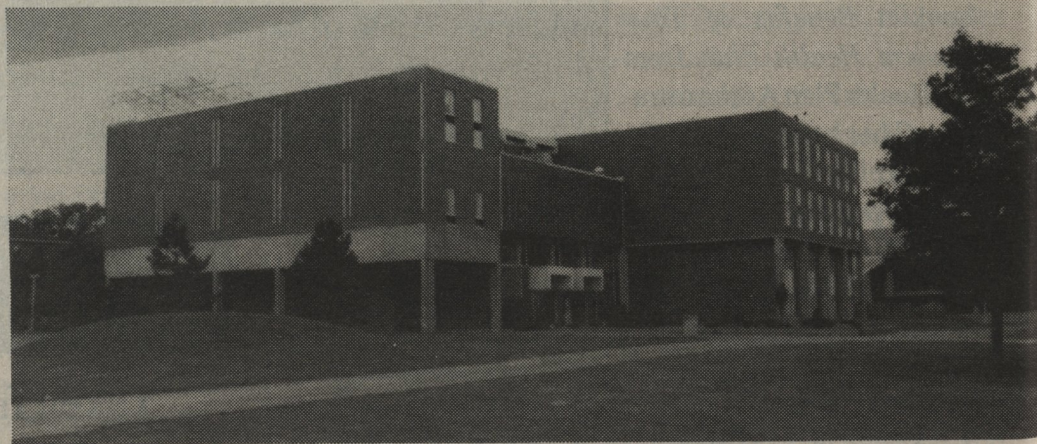
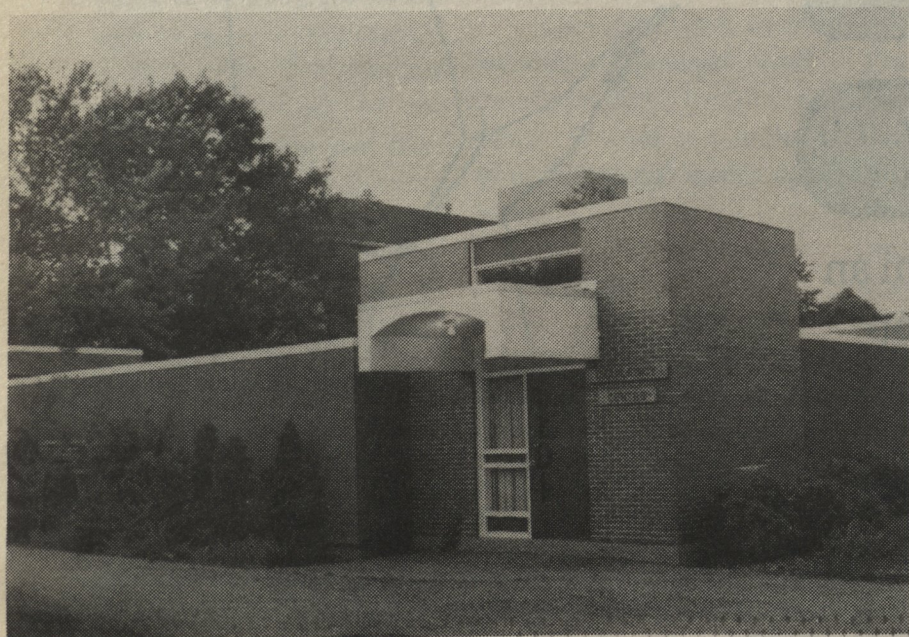

The Student Union Building or The Barn as it is more commonly known was renovated in 1971. Originally part of a farm on the SDU campus students in 1971 fought for the right to be able to open a pub in this building. The Barn is currently the home of the Panther Lounge, CIMN the radio station, a dance floors, and the Student Union Executive offices. During the year the Barn is host to many events for students, such as the ever popular Halloween, New Years, and St. Patricks Day Pub.

Main Building-Built between 1844 and 1855, Main Building currently houses the Faculty of Arts, with the exception of the department of psychology. Main originally housed a dormitory, refectory, science room and laboratory, and Chaplaincy hall. The population of St. Dunstons grew and the need to branch out began. After the University of Prince Edward Island came about Main underwent renovations again, during the 1988/89 Academic year.



Chaplaincy Centre-1965, was originally the SD Student Union Coffee Shop until the opening of the Barn in 1971. A bookstore operated there until the renovations to Kelley in 1974. The Chaplaincy Centre still meets the spiritual needs of the University Community.
