You are South, neither side vulnerable. The bidding has been:
West North East South
1♦ 1♠ Pass ?

What would you now bid with each of the following five hands?
1. ♠A J 4 ♥K Q 8 5 ♦J 2 ♣K 8 7
2. ♠K 8 5 2 ♥A 5 2 ♦A K 8 7
3. ♠A Q 7 5 ♥K 6 4 7 ♦K Q J 4 2
4. ♠A Q 6 ♥K J 5 ♦Q J 8 4 ♣A J 9 7
5. ♠K 7 ♠A J 6 ♥K Q 6 4 ♣K J 8 2

Two spades. Partner's overall in the one level ordinarily indicates a hand of less than opening bid strength. It is primarily a competitive bid directed at the exploration of part score possibilities rather than game. The overall is based much more on trick-taking potential than on high card values.

By inference, therefore, the suit in which the overall is made is a good one. Hence, A-J-x is ample trump support for a raise. The hearts should not be mentioned, since such a bid would tend to show a spade fit. The raise to two spades is made partly to show a possibility of game, but chiefly to preempt the opponents and at the same time to identify moderate strength.

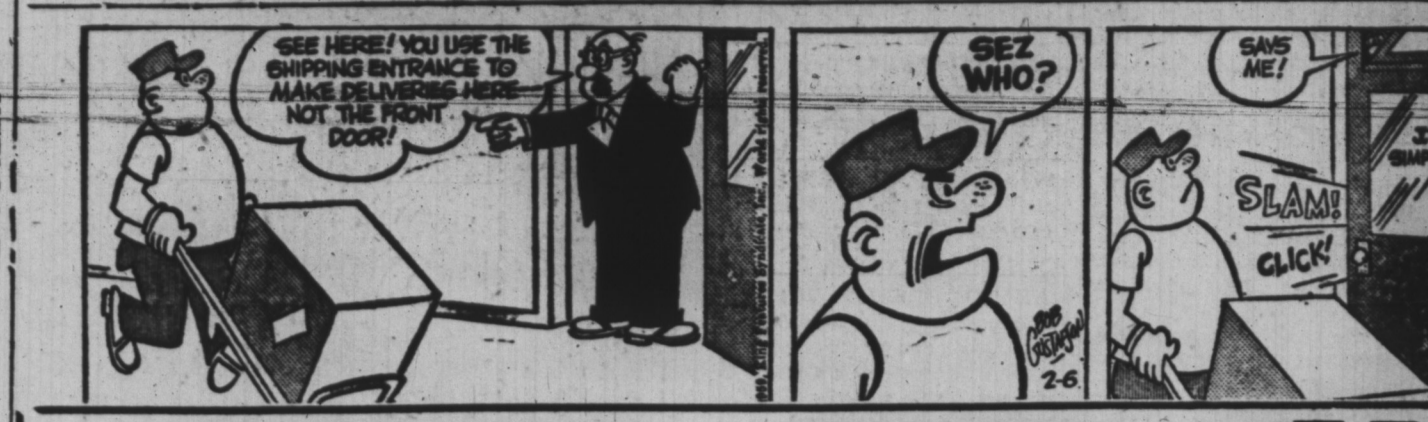

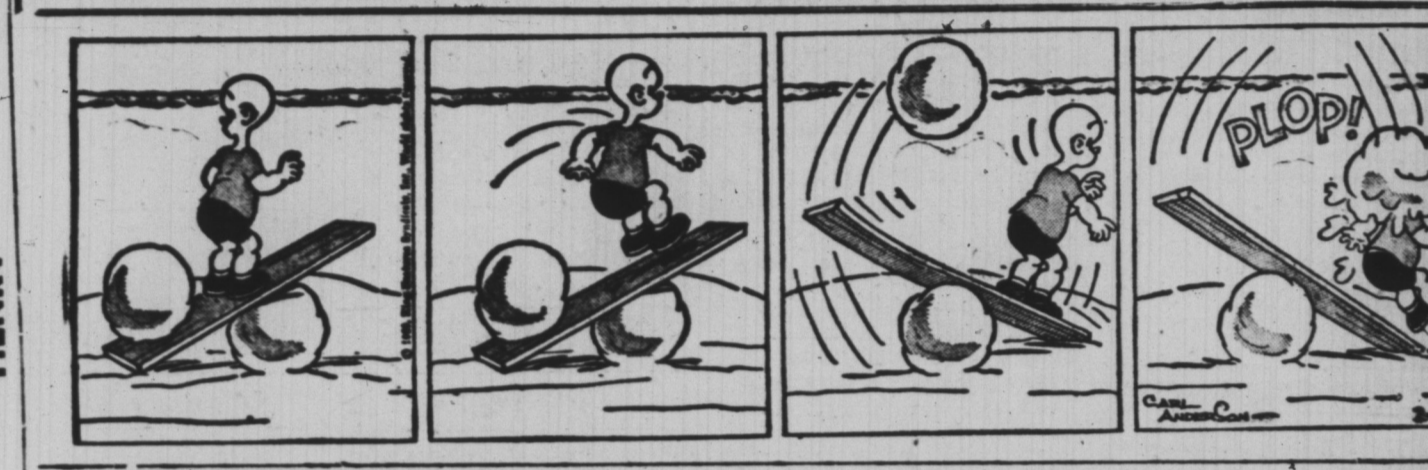
