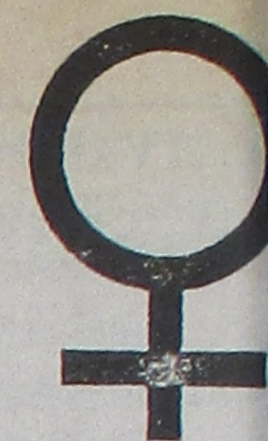

NEW DISCOVERIES IN MALE BIRTH CONTROL BREAKTHROUGHS

An entirely new method of birth control has been discovered. Apparently a tiny folded umbrella is inserted in the penis and opens automatically when it has reached the apex of the shaft. The underside of the umbrella contains a jelly like substance which causes the sperm to undergo a chemical change which renders the sperm incapable of fertilizing the egg.
