MONTREAL (CP) - The U.S. dollar closed Wednesday at a discount of 2.3-1/2 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, up 3-3/4. Pound sterling \$2.72, up 1/4.

Toronto Stocks

TORONTO (CP) - The stock market rallied in the final few minutes Wednesday to recover about half the ground lost in an earlier sudden sharp decline which was similar to the one which ripped through the market Tuesday.

Buying took over all sections in the last half hour and the trading pace quickened but still ended with a volume much lower than Tuesday. Final total sales were 1,430,000 shares against 4,032,000. Base metals recorded an index down 1/4 points after being down almost 3/4 points earlier. Western oils, with a 1/2 point, were almost unchanged from their index of 1.35. Senior base metals pushed the base metal index lower with losses confined to fractions. Juniors showed a few gains ranging to 1/2 cents but copper was lower.

Consolidated West. Pac. Trinidad, Security, North Canadian and National Petroleum were down between 9/16 and 5/16 cents among western oils. Great Plains dipped 1/4 while Calgary and Edmonton was down 1/4. Index losses: golds off .98 to 7/16; base metals off 1/16 to 1/16; western oils off 1/16 to 1/16.
