Pope John Suggested As Saint

VATICAN CITY (AP) — In the north Italian hillland of Pope John XXIII, a move was started Wednesday to make him a saint.

A petition signed by 50,000 people in Bergamo province was presented to a bishop of the Roman Catholic Church asking for proceedings to beatify Pope John, who died a year ago Wednesday. Beatification is a step

toward canonization as a saint. Bishop Clemente Gaddi of Bergamo said the petition would be sent promptly to the Congregation of Rites at the Vatican.

The Congregation handles causes for beatification and canonization. Beatification is the process of establishing that one may be publicly venerated by Roman Catholics in a particular area. It bestows the title of "blessed."

It will be up to Pope Paul and the Congregation of Rites to determine whether a cause for beatification should be opened. Vatican sources said a petition with so many names—showing popular devotion to John—could be a strong factor.

There is no fixed time for beatification. Pope Pius X was the last pontiff beatified and canonized. He died in 1914 and was beatified in 1951. He was canonized in 1954.

NEEDS MIRACLES
Normally the church requires

proof of what it considers two miracles for beatification, and two more for canonization. These involve the seemingly miraculous cure of sick persons.

Rev. Pietro Bosio, parish priest in John's hometown of Sotto il Monte, said there has been no church-recognized miracle for John. But he said there were stories of a girl recovering her eyesight and an elderly man regaining health, both through prayer to the late pope.

The initiative for collecting the names on the petition for Pope John was taken by priests of the Congregation of the Sacred Heart, a religious order in Bergamo.

Pope John, as a young priest, was secretary to the order's founder, Bishop Ruffini Tedeschi of Bergamo. Prelates, priests and nuns throughout the area were helped collect the signatures.

BANNERS HALF STAFF
The gold and white banners of Vatican City were lowered to half staff. Pope Paul VI led the homage of thousands to his predecessor, called "the pope of peace," the pope of Christian unity.

Pope Paul descended into the crypt beneath St. Peter's Basilica at 7 a.m. to say a requiem mass at an altar before the tomb of Pope John which pilgrims had decked with floral offerings.

Later in the basilica, Pope Paul attended a requiem mass for Pope John celebrated in the presence of 24 cardinals, Italian Premier Aldo Moro, diplomats attached to the Holy See, and 7,000 tourists and pilgrims. The mass was said by Giovanni Cardinal Urbani, archbishop of Venice where Pope John once had been patriarch.

Coal Carrier In Collision At Toronto

TORONTO (CP) — The new coal carrier Cape Breton Miner, dogged by misfortunes since its christening in Port Weller, Ont., May 25, collided with a harbor dredge and a small tug at the entrance to Toronto Harbor Wednesday.

The tug and dredge were damaged but the outbound Cape Breton Miner was not. No one was injured.

The dredge Shuniah's coo, Raymond Fougere, was thrown overboard by the impact but managed to pull himself back aboard, wet from the waist down.

One harbor official said: "The miracle is, no one was hurt."

A spokesman for the Toronto Harbor Commission said the collision occurred in early morning fog. When the Cape Breton Miner, leaving Toronto after unloading coal from Sydney, N.S., veered to avoid hitting a pipeline.

and dredge are owned by J.P. Porter Construction Company of Montreal.

The 630-foot Cape Breton Miner, owned by Upper Lakes Shipping Limited of Toronto, arrived from Canaugh, Ohio, last Thursday with 20,000 tons of coal for Ontario Hydro's Richard L. Hearn power plant. She found her self unloading boom would not work.

The coal was unloaded during the weekend after repairs, and Wednesday's collision interrupted briefly its voyage to Cape Breton to pick up 22,000 tons of coal for Ontario Hydro stations.

Third Wave Of Typhoid Is Feared

ABERDEEN (Reuters) — Health authorities expressed fear that a third wave of typhoid may be sweeping this Scottish city as 30 more persons were admitted to hospital Wednesday, bringing the total to 301 in the two-week epidemic.

A hunt was launched throughout Britain for cans of possibly infected corned beef—said to be the source of the outbreak.

Latest official figures listed 262 confirmed cases of typhoid and 39 suspected ones in the northeastern port city.

The only deaths reported here in connection with the typhoid communitarian banned corned beef from school menus and some other diseases.
