

- Northern Flicker - 1 mid-Dec. at Forest House, (Td'A); 2 in Charlottetown at feeder on and off all winter for 2nd year (JB); 1 on Mar. 5 at St. Catherines (DS)
- Downy Woodpecker - 1 perched on a Peakes Road feeder eating sunflower seeds for a few days in early Mar. (MM)
- Pileated Woodpecker - 1 flew across route 2 just west of Richmond on Jan. 23 (TeC); 1 calling at Springton, Jan. 28 (DS)
- American Crow - 263 flying over towards the dump in Sleepy Hollow between 8 and 9 a.m. but at 10 a.m. there was only 10 at the dump (EC)
- White-breasted Nuthatch - 1 at St. Catherines on Jan. 20 & 2 at Springton on Feb. 7 to 15 (DS)
- Brown Creeper - 1 at Green Park, Jan. 5 (LH); 1 at Springton, Feb. 7 (DS)
- American Robin - 5 at West River Causeway, Jan. 1 (EC); 2 at Green Park, Jan. 5 (LH); 2 at Cherry Valley, Feb. 1 (JH); 6 at Mt Stewart, Feb. 10 (WM); 5 in pin cherry at Battery Point, Feb. 12 (WP); 32 Feb. 2 & 10, down to 6 by Feb. 14 at Brackley Beach (DS); 1 at St. Catherines on Feb. 13 (DS); 12 in Mermaid on Mar. 16 (WM); 3 at Cherry Valley on Feb. 19 (JH); robins on road edge at St. Catherines on Mar. 5 (DS); 7 singles on South Rustico Cymbria road loop on Mar. 7 (RP)
- Bohemian Waxwing - 1 Mar. 2 on Brighton Road (C&SH); 12 in Charlottetown, Mar. 11 (JB); mixed group of 30 Cedar and Bohemian Waxwings at Oyster Bed Bridge (RP, LT)
- Northern Shrike - 1 at Kellys Cross, Dec. 31 (JM); 1 chasing chickadees at Donagh feeder, Jan. 11 (JDM); 1 at Cape Bear, Jan. 4 (BCP); 1 at Basin Head, Jan. 23 (BCP); 2 at Abrams Village on Feb. 23 (BH, DS, RC, RP, LT, JDM); 1 at Dunk River Feb. 23 (RC, RP, LT)
- Yellow-rumped Warbler - 1 immature at Savage Harbour on Feb. 8 (BCP)
- Warbler sp. - at Belmont feeder from late Jan. to Feb. 3 (HM)
- Red-winged Blackbirds - 2 at Milltown Cross feeder Jan. 23 (LA)
- Grackle - 3 at Milltown Cross feeder, Jan. 23 (LA); 6 at Milltown Cross feeder, Feb. 6 (J&RT)
- Northern Cardinal - 1 male seen in a tree with Bohemian Waxwing, Charlottetown, March 12 (JB)
- Evening Grosbeaks - 50 daily at feeder in Arlington reported Jan. 27 (LP); 3 dozen at Indian River feeder in January (TC)
- Purple Finch - 6 in Charlottetown, Jan. 21 (C&SH); 2 at Kinlock Road, Feb. 3 (MLM); 6 to 8 at Battery Point, Feb. 4 (WP); 15 at Anglo Rustico, Feb. 6 (SB)
- House Finch - male at Alberry Plains on Feb. 16 (RCu); 1 at Summerville on Feb. 16 (FRC)
- Pine Grosbeak - 1 at Springton on Jan. 31 (DS); 8 to 9 with Purple Finch, Robins, and Bohemian Waxwing, Feb. 4 & 5 (BCP); many including 1 flock of 5 at Springton on Feb. 7; 1 at St. Catherines on Feb. 13 (DS); 1 Feb. 13 & 15 at Springton (DS); 20 Feb. 20 at Green Bay in white spruce (WM)
- Common Redpoll - 35 at South Melville, Jan. 26 (EC); 30 at Donagh feeding on Larch cones, Feb. 15 (JDM); DS notes that "I rarely counted redpolls because they were so numerous this winter, probably the most common bird in P.E.I. this winter. I literally see or hear hundreds, if not thousands, each day I'm in the field. By late Feb, the numbers were falling off. (Jan & Feb, 1992); 200+ feeding on cones on Route 6 near Dalvay (RP)
- Hoary Redpoll - 1 possible at Desable on Mar. 13 with 8 to 9 Common Redpoll (BP)
- Pine Siskin - 3 on Feb. 7, 6 on Feb. 8, and 2 on Feb. 15 at Springton (DS); 60 at DeSable on Mar. 13th, some chases occurring between males and females (BP)
