**ROBERT AND MARY STANFIELD FOUNDATION BILINGUAL EXCHANGE SCHOLARSHIPS IN CANADIAN STUDIES**

Two scholarships valued at \$3,500 will be awarded for the academic year to students who wish to pursue their Canadian Studies in a language other than their own at a Canadian

university which is a member or affiliated to a member of the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada. Fields of studies: i.e. Canadian Northern Studies, Canadian Area Studies, French Canadian Studies, Native Studies, Canadian Politics and History, Canadian Foreign Policy, Economic Studies relating to Canada, Canadian Urban Studies and Canadian Languages and Literatures.

DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 1, 1979

**THE MCEUEN SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded annually in memory of Dr. Charles Stuart McEuen to a Canadian student resident in Canada who is of Scottish ancestry, or is the son or daughter of an alumnus of the University of St. Andrews.

The Scholarship is tenable for a three-year course of studies toward the ordinary degree or a four-year course toward an honours degree. It is renewable from year to year on the basis of satisfactory performance, and covers all tuition fees and residence costs and a stipend for basic expenses.

Applicants must be more than 21 years of age and must be attending university in Canada or be qualified for admission into a university in Canada. The winner is chosen on the basis of academic achievement and leadership potential. DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 15, 79

**U.P.E.I. AWARDS**
