Pope Pius Warns Dangers From Hereditary Diseases

VATICAN CITY (Reuters) — Pope Pius, warning of the dangers of hereditary diseases, has suggested that clinics should be set up to give guidance on such problems. Praising work in this field by the Dight Institute in the United States, he suggested similar institutes elsewhere where married and engaged couples could consult confidentially "in order to insure better the happiness and security of their union." The pontiff was speaking last Friday at Castel Gandolfo, his summer residence, to a large group of research specialists attending talks in Rome on trans-fusions and blood diseases. His address was made public Tuesday.

The majority of the total, \$7,204,883, was for construction of Trans - Canada Highway, and roads and bridges through national parks. Of the remainder, \$2,429,363 was for new works, \$387,855 was for repair and improvements.

At the time of her death she was 1st vice-president of the Catholic Women's League for the diocese of Charlottetown.
