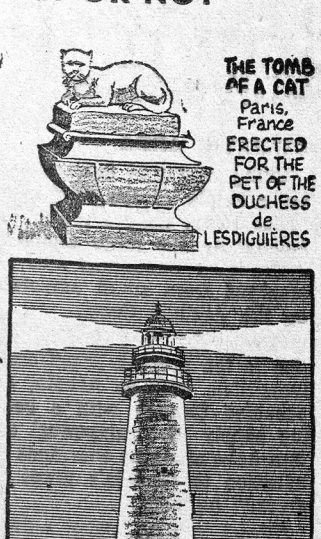

The bidding:
West North East South
1♥ 1♣ 3♥ 3♠
4♥ 4♠

Opening lead—king of hearts. The jump raise, over an infor-matory double, is not a strength showing bid, as is evidenced by East's three heart bid. It is purely preemptive in nature and shows great length in partner's suit with relatively little in high cards.

South properly came in with three spades. Though his high card content was also low, the distribution was more than sufficient to justify a free bid. North, of course, carried on to four.

The king of hearts was opened and ruffed. Declarer then led a spade to the ace and another back to the king. When it turned out that West had a trump trick, South started to run the club
