Mr. CAMPBELL moved that sections 32 and 33 and sub-section 45 be struck out and the clauses giving the former arrangement of Districts in King's County substituted.

180. It shall not be lawful for any person to vote at any election to be held for the election of a member or members to represent in the Legislative Assembly of this province any Electoral District at any time within 30 days before the day of election...
