For the children, there is a Firelight Story, by Livingston B. Morse; entertaining Pastimes, by Lina Beard, describing the construction of the Statue of Zeus at Olympia; an amusing story by C. V. C. Matthews, called We Meet Monsieur Daguerre, and a Sewing Lesson. In addition there are numerous articles by experts treating problems of the home and household.
