We can talk and we like of 'social revolutions' and kindred evils that are supposed to threaten this nation. When they do threaten our institutions the danger signal will not come from the back country. Such thoughts are born and fed amid the four atmosphere of the cities. In the clear country air of the farm nothing threatens this country, and when anything in the shape of a scholastic, anarchistic revolution does menace this land the true voice which will stamp it out will come from the country. The backbone of this land rests in the country and on the farm."



THE PHILIPPINES

Compliments Pass When Gentle Folks Meet.

CHICAGO, Sept 27.—Major General Francis C. Greene, of the American army of liberation of the Philippines, and Senor Felipe Agencilla, Vice president of Aguinaldo's revolutionary government, arrived in Chicago yesterday, en route to Washington.

Senor Agencilla said: "In all my historical studies I have paid the most attention to the growth of the power and influence of the United States government. It is my ideal of a government, and it is the pattern which the Philippine people will follow when they are independent. This is the land that we have looked up to for many years, and the one in whose footsteps we have tried to follow."

Senor Agencilla discredited the report that France had promised to recognize the Philippine republic, and intimated that his sole hope of independence were with President McKinley and the government of the United States.

Gen. Greene expressed a very high opinion of the Philippines as men and fighters. The inhabitants of the island, he said, were superior in every way to the Cubans or to the North American Indians, and once they were freed from Spanish oppression had a magnificent future before them. Gen. Greene and Senor Agencilla left for Washington later in the day.
