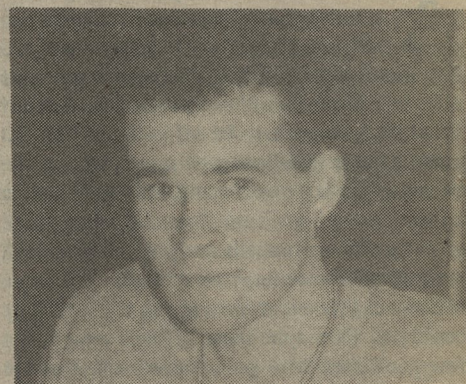
5. *I will be voting for the candidate rather than*

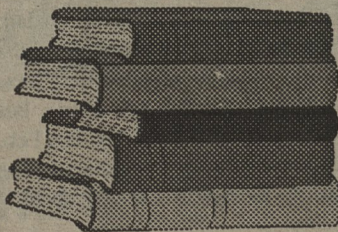
