WINNIPEG, May 29 - (CP) - Coarse grain futures prices closed mostly higher today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange with fair commercial demand in oats and barley. There were shipping orders in oats and barley and other sales of barley to the continent. Rye received some support on reports of damage to the flax crop in the United States. The uncertain international scene also was considered a stimulating factor. Overnight loadings of Canadian wheat for export were United Kingdom 1,100 bushels, Switzerland 340,000, India 315,000, Norway 150,000, and Belgium 40,000.
