Toronto Stocks

TORONTO, (CP)—Base metals
and western oils were at new
highs for the year on Wednesday's
stock market session.
Volume was 2,385,000 shares.
Higher-priced western oils were
ahead in late trading. Pacific,
Canada Southern, Great Plains
and Calgary-Edmonton added
more than 50 cents to lead.
Base metal seniors were all
stronger and several, including
Consolidated Smelters, Falcon-
bridge and Noranda, were at
new highs during the day. Man-
itowadge-area issues were ahead
although down slightly from their
forenoon peak. Juniors were also
stronger. Golds were up in strong
active trading throughout the
period and Ventures was ahead \$1
to lead holding companies. Uran-
ium and Bathurst-area base met-
als were fractionally higher in
moderate trading.

The exchange's closing indexes
showed golds up .71 at 73.86, base
metals up 1.09 at 150.97 and west-
ern oils up 1.20 at 101.20.
