Kauai King Seen Favorite In Preakness Race Today

BALTIMORE (AP) — Kauai King, the pride of Maryland, puts his glittering three-year-old record on the line Saturday as the outstanding favorite to take the 91st Preakness and move one race closer to a sweep of the triple crown classics.

The front-running winner of the Kentucky Derby, with a record of seven victories and one second in nine 1956 starts, takes on eight rivals at 1 3/16 miles. Victory would leave the son of Native Dancer within one triumph — the Belmont Stakes June 4 — of the coveted triple crown last won by Citation in 1948.

With clear weather and a fast track, Pimlico officials are looking for a crowd of more than 40,000. Post time will be 5:46 p.m. EDT, with CBS telecasting the show from 5:30 to 6 p.m. EDT.

If the \$1,000 starting fee is posted for all nine entries, the run for the Black-Eyed Susans will be worth \$181,500. The winner will earn \$120,000 with second worth \$30,000, third \$15,000 and fourth, \$7,500.

Kauai King, owned by 41-year-old Michael Ford of Omaha, Neb., trained by Henry Forrest and ridden by Don Brumfield, is the even money choice to become the first Maryland-bred colt to capture the Preakness since his sire in 1953.

Native Dancer, missed the triple crown when he lost the only race of his career to Dark Star in the Kentucky Derby.

Kauai King went to the front at the start of this year's Kentucky Derby and never was headed, beating Mrs. Ada L. Rice's Advocator by one-half length with Blue Skyer, owned by Marvin Padgett and Hugh Grant, only a nose behind in third place and Mrs. H. C. Phipps' Stupendous fourth, two lengths out of first place.

Johnny Rotz, who'll be aboard Indulto, and Ron Turcotte of Grand Falls, N.B., who'll pilot lightly regarded Rehabilitate, are the only other jockeys who have scored in the Preakness. Rotz won with Greek Money in 1962 and Turcotte with Tom Rolfe last year.

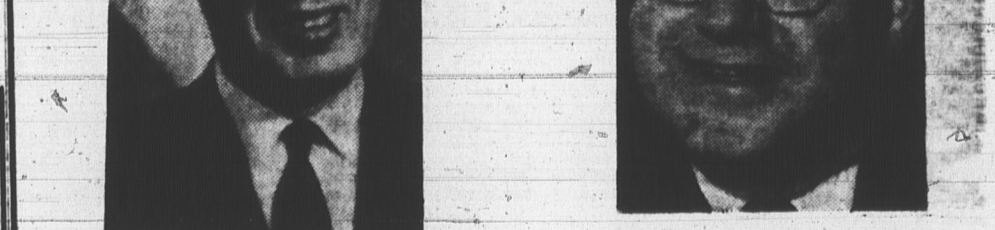
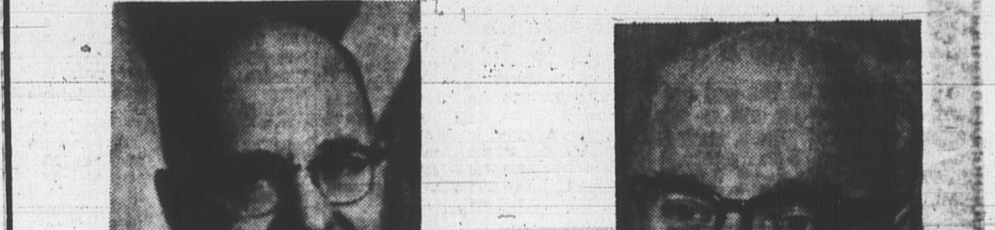
