Long Sault Rapids Sealed

CORNWALL, Ont. (CP) - The historic Long Sault rapids on the St. Lawrence River were sealed off Thursday. A 50-foot gap in a coffer dam extending from the Canadian mainland to Long Sault Island in New York state was closed by the Walsh Construction Company. The American firm is working for the New York state power authority on part of the St. Lawrence Seaway project. The final link in the 1,440-foot coffer dam was completed by dropping steel frames into the river, backed up by tons of rock. Sealing off the rapids was a major phase in the seaway development. They have been a barrier to shipping since navigation on the river began. The Long Sault rapids was the scene of a heroic stand in 1660 by Dollard des Oreilles who with 15 French companions defended a fort there for a week against a much larger force of Iroquois. Dollard and his companions were all killed.

Federal Hospital Insurance Bill Gets 2nd Reading

OTTAWA (CP) - The government's hospital insurance bill received second reading in the Commons Thursday but before opposition members urged a speed-up and broadening of the plan. Under the bill, the federal government is committed to pay half the costs of standard ward hospital care and diagnostic services when six provinces representing a majority of Canada's population have legislation in force authorizing their participation. Five have agreed so far. Stanley Knowles (CFC - Winnipeg North Centre) said enough of the provinces representing enough of the country's population have accepted the plan for it to go ahead now. The five provinces now committed comprised 56.3 per cent of Canada's population, including the Northwest Territories and the Yukon. "The addition of Prince Edward Island, for instance, would increase the number of provinces to six but that addition would increase the population percentage to only 59.3 per cent. This much of an increase - 6 per cent - is hardly enough to justify a delay in getting the scheme into effect." Dr. William Blair (PC - Lanark) said mental disease should be recognized as a qualifying ailment under the plan. "Not to be recognized is a backward step." There were 10,000 more patients in mental hospitals in Canada than in all other types of hospitals in the country put together.

Nurses To Attend Congress in Rome

OTTAWA (CP) - Nearly 250 Canadian nurses are expected to attend the 11th International Council of Nurses' Congress in Rome May 27 to June 1, the Canadian Nurses' Association announced Thursday. The Canadian delegation - fourth largest of the delegations from 60 nations - is to be led by CNA President Trema Hunter of Vancouver and general secretary Pearl Stiver of Ottawa. More than 3,000 nurses are expected to attend the Rome meeting.
