The Duke of Grafton has been made a Knight of the Garter. Lord Napier, of Magdala, has been raised to the rank of field marshal.

The appointment of the Bishop of Canterbury, has been received with general satisfaction by all parties in the Church.

The Czar has instructed the Russian ambassadors abroad to report to him personally their views on the political situation in Europe.

Sir Charles Dilke, in an address at Chelsea to-day, expressed a hope that he would hear no more talk about the retirement of Mr. Gladstone.

Albert Victor, eldest son of the Prince of Wales, and next in succession to the British Crown to his father, has been entered for Oxford University for the next term.

The mayor of Wexford, who is proprietor of a local paper, has been sentenced to five weeks' imprisonment for publishing a report of a meeting of the Ladies' League calculated to cause intimidation.

A marvellous escape is reported in connection with the recent disaster at Bradford, Edgland. A boy who was in the building which was crushed by the fall of a factory chimney was several days after, picked out of the ruins alive.

Canadian volunteers will be interested in hearing that the Council of the National Rifle Association have decided to abolish the shooting at 1,000 yards for the Queen's Prize. The reason for this is the very just and proper one that at that range the Martini-Henry cannot be depended upon, at recent scores prove beyond all dispute.

The second stage of the great competition at Wimbledon will, therefore, in future consist only of the 800 and 900 yards ranges. The change will be generally approved.

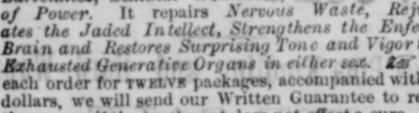
