to be a member of the Board of Governors
to be responsible for the financial administration of union funds
to be Chairman of a Finance Committee composed of the Comptroller, Treasurer, and other members of the Union
to be appointed by the Council
to submit on request a financial statement of union funds or not less than

monthly at Council meetings
e) submit the results of the yearly audit not less than 14 days after termination of office.
f) permit students to have access to the financial records of the union within 24 hours of request, properly posted
g) keep regular business hours not less than 10 hours per week and not less than 1 hour per week day
h) keep a clear and ac-

curate account of all financial transactions of the union
i) be the co-signing authority with the Comptroller
j) perform other duties as required

a) be responsible for all physical facilities which are student owned or student controlled and be responsible for the appropriate committees
b) be a co-signing authority with the Treasurer
c) be Chairman of the Coffee Shop Bard of Governors if applicable

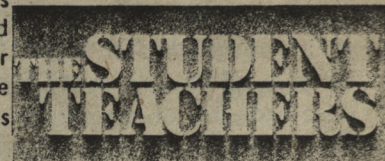
