

**Kilmuir Native Is Combining Nuclear Science And Religion**

Dr. Lanchin D. MacDonald, professor of philosophy at Wichita University in Kansas for the past five years, has recently accepted a position as consultant in the research division of the Lockheed Aircraft Corp., Los Angeles, Calif. Dr. MacDonald is a native of Kilmuir, P.E.I. and is a graduate of Prince of Wales College.

Dr. MacDonald for a number of summers was a consultant at the U.S. Pacific Missile Range at Point Mugu, California and with General Dynamics Corp., Fort Worth, Texas as senior research physicist. He has been attached continuously as consultant to the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies at Oak Ridge, Tenn.

Dr. MacDonald came to Wichita from the University of Florida five years ago, and although a scientist is also an ordained minister. He is a past-president of the Wichita Council of Churches.

He has two books in the process of being published. One, "John Grote" is being published in the Netherlands, while his "Philosophy of Science" will be published this fall in the United States.

Dr. MacDonald is a brother of John K. MacDonald and Anne MacDonald, RN, of Kilmuir.

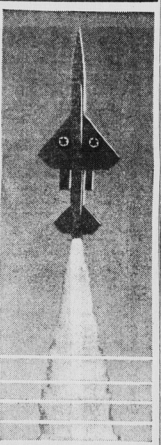
