

**THOUSANDS OF DOLLARS THUS SWEEPED AWAY**  
**Industry in That Section Crippled Beyond Recovery This Season.**

 ALBERTON, June 22.  
 Heavy gales of northerly winds accompanied by drenching rain after a north west thunder storm, did much damage last night along the north coast.  
 From North Cape to Tignish it is reported that all the boats of the numerous fishing establishment are smashed up and traps strewn along the shore.  
 Thousands of dollars of poor packers money is thus swept away and the industry in this section is crippled beyond recovery for the season.  
 No lives are reported lost.
