

The Prohibition Plebiscite.

At a regular meeting of Eastern Gem Lodge, I. O. G. T., North Lake on the 6th inst., the following resolution was passed unanimously and the undersigned were appointed a committee to draft copies and forward them to our representative at Ottawa and to the press:

Whereas, the unrestricted traffic in intoxicating liquors throughout the Dominion of Canada is an evil of giant proportions, the inveterate enemy of morality and religion and the great destroyer of domestic peace and happiness.

And Whereas, there are a great and increasing number of the population who are working, praying and hoping for the abatement of this terrible scourge and who believe that the passing of a law, prohibiting the manufacture, importation and sale of intoxicating liquors, as beverages, would be an act of incalculable benefit to Canada, freeing the people from the curse of rum and allowing them to make giant strides in everything tending to make Canada what she is destined to be—one of the foremost nations of the world.

And, Whereas, previous to the last Dominion election the leader of the Opposition—now the Premier of Canada,—sought the support of the temperance people, assuring them if his party should succeed in gaining power, he would submit the question of prohibition to the people at the polls, and further assuring them that he would abide by the decision.

And, Whereas, notwithstanding the fact that the Government exerted its influence to defeat the temperance workers, a majority of nearly 14,000 votes was recorded in favor of a prohibitory law.

And, Whereas, after having declared in unmistakable terms his intention of abiding by the will of the people, the leader of the Government now refuses to introduce a prohibitory bill on the plea that he meant not a majority of the votes polled but a majority of the whole electorate.

Therefore Resolved, that such resort to craft and dishonesty is incompatible with the high and responsible position of Premier of Canada, and that unless the Government hastens to make amends it will be the imperative duty of every true temperance advocate, as well as of every lover of honesty and fair play, to withdraw and withhold his confidence and support from a party which stands convicted, but unrepentant of such gross deceit, duplicity and treachery.
