

Official Opening of High School Tonight



QUEEN CHARLOTTE HIGH SCHOOL

Marks Milestone In Civic History

The official opening of Queen Charlotte High School this evening at eight o'clock will mark the successful conclusion of an event looked forward to for many years by citizens who were convinced that such an addition to the City school system was absolutely necessary.

Although the High School has been occupied and in operation since the City schools were opened early in September, further work was necessary, particularly in the auditorium-gymnasium, before the building could be declared completed and the official opening arranged.

437 students are enrolled this term, occupying fourteen of the eighteen classrooms, with a maximum seating capacity of 630. Two additional rooms are available for Art and Visual education. There is also a science room for demonstration and teaching purposes. The library and music room is also suitable for small group assemblies where seating can be arranged for up to 100.

The recreation room in the basement is fitted up with the necessary equipment for noon-day lunch, which is eaten under supervision.

INDUSTRIAL ARTS
Approximately 200 boys and girls receive instruction each week in Industrial Arts and Household Science. Additional classes are being organized. All students in the High School are being instructed in music, with each class having one period each week.
