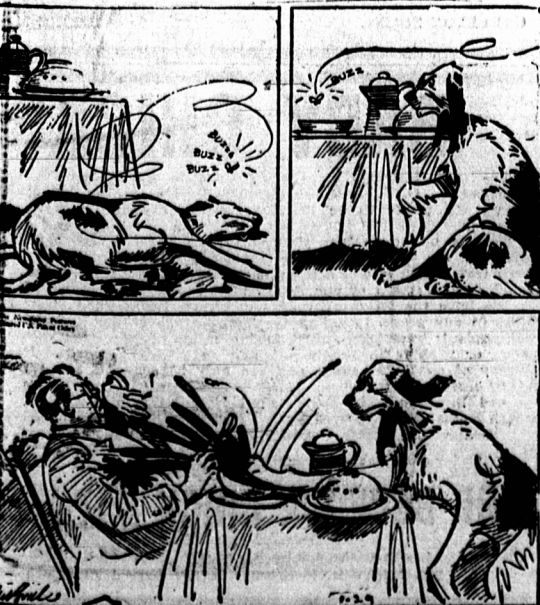

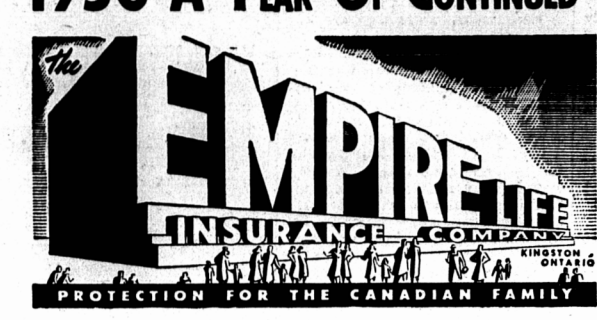

No Unanimity Re Rental Controls

(By The Canadian Press) Only three of the 10 Canadian Provinces have taken action to keep rental controls alive when the Federal government abandons them April 30. A fourth Province — Newfoundland — is an exception since it had its own rental controls in effect before it united with Canada in 1949 and still has them in operation. A survey taken by the Canadian Press in provincial capitals indicates that in only Quebec, Alberta and Saskatchewan have the provincial authorities taken legislative steps to continue rental controls. The other Provinces either have no intention of entering that field or appear to be waiting to see whether the Federal government might decide to extend the life of its controls. However, authorities have given no indication that they plan to seek a continuation of their ceilings, despite inflationary pressures building up in the wake of the country's expanding program of preparedness. If the Federal Government plans to ask for such a continuation, and there is no ground to think it does — notice likely will be given in the speech from the throne at the parliamentary opening Tuesday next. It was a year ago that the Federal government announced intention to abandon the controls. The position now is that it can continue controls legally only if parliament declares that a state of emergency exists. The present controls, largely reduced from their wartime status, constitute restrictions on eviction and unauthorized increases in rents. Newly-constructed dwellings are control-free, as are residences which become vacant. Along with the government's announced intention last year to give up controls this year went a long-standing federal offer to pay for the first year of administration of rent restrictions by any province which wished to take them over.

Steel Production Record In The U.S.

CLEVELAND, Jan. 28 — (AP) — American steel mills have posted their second all-time production record within two weeks, Steel magazine says today. Total production last week amounted to an estimated 2,000,000 tons, the metal-working journal says. The previous week a record was set when 1,991,000 tons were rolled out. That had topped a previous mark of 1,988,000 tons set in mid-November. Noting that more steel producing facilities are being built, the magazine predicts that the U.S. might turn out more than 100,000,000 tons this year. Capacity at present is rated at 104,229,850 tons annually. Production last week was at 100 per cent of capacity. The previous week it had been at 95.5 per cent of capacity.
