

News Notes

Rumors come from Hayti of another threatened revolution. The musical exhibition closed at Vienna with a deficit of \$50,000. Heavy rains have caused considerable damage to the cotton crop in Texas. Immense quantities of coal and tin have recently been discovered in Australia. Four months of drought in Southern Russia has reduced the peasants to despair. Premier Abbott and Hon. Mr. Foster have left Montreal for England on the steamer Parisian. Despatches to the New York Herald, from Berlin, represent that the political crisis is for the time settled. The crisis arose out of the strained relations of Von Caprivi, the Prime Minister of the empire, over the military bill. Submitting to the directions of the Emperor, the Premier of Prussia and Dr. Miquel, the Finance Minister in the Prussian Cabinet, have agreed to support the military bill, or at least not to oppose it. They were opposed to this measure because it is so severe, and on the technical ground that it was presented to the Cabinet in the name of Prussia, while Prussia had not assented to it. As a matter of fact all Germany is opposed to the bill, and there appears to be no doubt whatever that it will be rejected by the German Parliament. But the Emperor is reported to have declared that he is bound to have the measure passed. It is stated that he said: "This time I shall go to the bitter end. If necessary, we will dissolve the Reichstag, and if the new majority should also be hostile we will continue dissolving until the bill is passed." All of the ministers who are opposed to the bill either directly or indirectly will be dismissed. It is needless to say that these reports cause much anxiety in Germany, and, indeed, throughout Europe. They have revived rumors respecting the Emperor's health, and these rumors take on various forms, according to the feelings, or desires, or perhaps designs, of those who are more immediately affected.
