MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) — The industrial section of the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges suffered its worst loss of the month in moderate trading on Thursday.
 Papers were the biggest losers, but turnover was light. Declines range to two points. Abitibi was down 1 1/2 at 37 1/2, and Great Lakes was off 2 at 39 1/2.
 Base metals also fell with Nickel off 1 1/2 at 92 1/2. Other metals were fractions lower.
 Banks and refining oils were generally fractional but Imperial Oil advanced 1-1/4 at 43.
 Losses about equalled gains in the utilities.
 Pipelines, beverages and textiles were fractions lower. Construction, western oils, foods and steels were mixed in a mainly narrow range.
 The mines and oils were generally lower in fairly active trading.
 The closing averages show the banks up .14 at 61.41, utilities up .2 at 158.1, a new high, industrials off 1 at 317.2, combined off .5 at 264.2, papers off 6.1 at 469 and golds up .77 at 89.8.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) — The stock market dropped back in light trading Thursday with base metal down around one-half on index and golds off a few decimal points.
 Western oils slipped from their high but retained at least a few decimal points on the session.
 The final volume was 4,289,000 shares, well below Wednesday's 6,212,000. It was the lightest day since March 2. Speculative issues were not overly active. Radiore had the best gain, up 10 cents at \$1.43 as it recovered from an early 15-cent loss. Rockwell was up 8 cents at 46 and Can-Erin added 5 cents at \$1.30.
 Juniors were weak in a 10-cent range among golds and the section lost despite a 1/2 gain at 33 by Hollinger. Canadian gold kilo bars were quoted at \$34.12 to \$34.17.
 Western oils gained but it was a far cry from Wednesday when they swept ahead for the best index gain in a year. Calgary and Edmonton had the best advance, up 1/2 at \$1. Pennina added 1/4 at 10 1/2. Among lower-priced oils National Pete added 40 cents at \$4.45.
 Senior base metal mines were

weak. International Nickel dipped 1 point, Hudson Bay 1/2 and Noranda 3/4.
 The market was one of the broadest on exchange records as 708 issues traded. The best previous day was 705 issues.
 Index changes: golds off .16 to 89.85; base metals off .55 to 188.04; western oils up .07 to 135.86.
