Quebec Court Sustains Religious Sect's Appeal

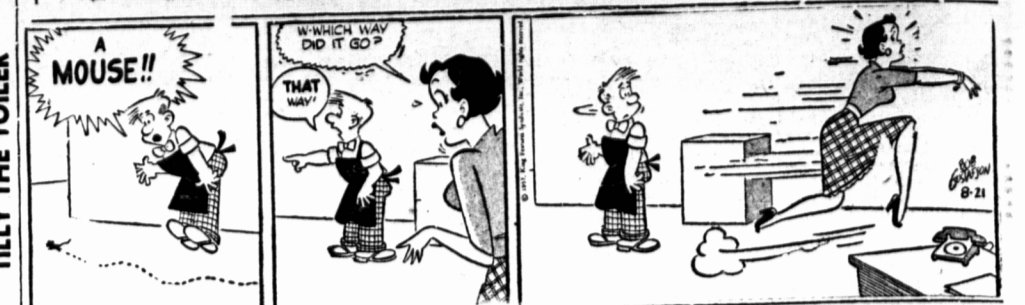
