Brazil, for example, use extracts of the roots of certain plants which will completely cure dysentery when all other treatments have failed.

Iron-headed tomahawks were the invention of white men and not Indians as most persons believe.

True, the North American redmen possessed crude stone-headed hatchets before the arrival of Europeans, but the white man increased this weapon's deadliness by adding the iron. The original Indian tomahawk was the invention of an Algonquin redskin.

There are some strange marriage customs in various parts of the world, the strangest of which I shall give here.

In parts of the East Indies the lovers run away and live together

for some time before they are considered married.

Among the Uarayu Indians of South America the young man must display his skill with bow and arrow in order to prove to his prospective father-in-law that he will be able to support a family with fish and game.

Marriage by purchase is still in vogue especially in countries where there are more men than women. Brides being a fancy price, but they must also have a large dowry. A good wife fourteen or fifteen years old could, for example, be bought with six cows or their equivalent in currency.

Among the natives of the island of Madagascar widows with children are preferred to young girls. Why? Many women of those tribes never have children, a condition which still baffles medical authorities. Thus a bride who can bring to her husband a new supply of hunters and female workers is a prize worth contending for.

The groom has no say in the selection of his bride in the Pon-

ape Island, in the South Pacific. His mother selects his wife and ties the marriage knot and that's all there is to it, "believe it or not."

Thus it may be seen that different countries have different customs, but there is one custom that is universal, namely: that a wedding is followed by feasting and drinking and wishing the bride and groom happiness and a hopeful future.

Maidens of the South Pacific islands marry at the age of ten, and the wooing and selecting of a mate is entirely in their hands.

Very remarkable is the fact that worms are able to move backwards and forwards by means of vertical undulations and not by lateral movements as do other limbless creatures.

In order to shed its skin without injury to itself a snake actually turns its skin inside out. Some species of snakes lay eggs while

others give birth to the young.

The North American Bull snake, is so named from the fact that when excited it produces a noise similar to a bellowing bull.

No white man has ever yet learned the secret of the most deadly and swift of all known poisons called, curare poisons. And what is more remarkable, only professional poisonmakers of certain Indian tribes know the magic recipe which is passed down from father to son. Incidentally, curare is the poison used in that savage weapon known as a blowgun. A man or beast struck by a curare-tipped dart will die within five minutes after the poison has entered the blood-stream.

And oddly enough, the blowguns with their deadly curare are made by different tribes, which may be the principal reason why the whole thing is wrapped in mystery.

The lasso is also the invention of the American Indians, so, too, is the game of Lacrosse, tennis baseball and hockey, though their method of playing them differs considerably from ours. And they played rough, too. For instance, if the umpire rendered a decision which seemed unpopular to the spectators he usually was dragged from the scene unconscious.

Thus it may be seen that not all inventions have come by the hand and brain of the white race, though the latter quite frequently gets all the credit.
