

Soviets Have Curious Way Of Reacting To Spy Cases

MOSCOW (CP)—The Soviets have a curious way of reacting to spy cases in Canada involving Soviet diplomats.

They print newspaper articles complaining about an anti-Soviet "smear campaign" in Canada implying that the Canadian government either tolerates the campaign or actually abets it. Canadian residents here, why? noting the printed attacks on their country that appear at irregular intervals, have taken to turning the charge around and talking about an "anti-Canada campaign" in the Soviet press.

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Soviet relations. He had talks with all the important people from Communist party boss Leonid Brezhnev on down—which is far better than even heads of state normally do in Moscow.

Both sides succeeded in ignoring any danger to the success of the talks posed by Canada's latest spy case, involving two Soviet diplomats, that had already broken when Martin began his journey.

Investia probably broke all records for oblique writing by referring to the case in the following manner: "Paul Martin travels to Moscow to conduct negotiations on the promotion of contacts between Canada and the U.S.S.R. while those who claim to express public opinion embark upon a new round of anti-Soviet sallies."

POSES QUESTION

It claimed that "prominent Canadian leaders" had joined the campaign. At another point the newspaper asked how "provocations" against Soviet personnel in Ottawa could be reconciled with the Canadian government's expressed desire for better relations with Russia.

Thus, although not directly accusing the Pearson government of fostering the "anti-Soviet campaign," it contrives to hold it responsible. The suspicion that the Investia blast was basically a reaction to the latest spy case in Canada flows from the fact that a spate of almost identical articles appeared in the Soviet press last spring at the height of the Victor Spencer and Gerda Muninger cases.

PROTEST OFFICIALLY

That particular series of attacks culminated in an official protest against what the Kremlin called an "anti-Soviet campaign" in Canada and "provocations" against Soviet citizens there—the same charges made in the latest Investia article.

A peculiarity common to most of the anti-Canada articles published in the last year or so is that they don't specifically deny espionage allegations against Soviet diplomats serving in Canada.

Soviet newspapers never print news of spy charges against Soviet people in the West. The closest they come to it, in the case of Canada, is to talk about "absurdities" in the Canadian press about espionage, as Investia did, or to denounce "spy mania" in Canada, as a Soviet newspaper did last May.

U.S. Rushes Military Aid To Jordan

WASHINGTON (AP)—The U.S. state department has announced the United States is rushing military equipment "to strengthen the defensive capability" of Jordan.

In addition to defensive equipment, the United States also is beginning the delivery of an undisclosed number of F-104 aircraft, the announcement said. The state department acknowledged a month ago that King Hussein of Jordan requested additional military aid in the wake of the Nov. 13 Israeli attack on the village of Es Samu.

Thursday night's announcement, though it did not spell out the kind or amount of assistance the United States will provide, was unusual. Normally the state department does not announce military assistance programs to the Middle East, an area where it is particularly opposed to the arms race.

AIRLIFT ARMS

The announcement said a substantial portion of the equipment will be airlifted to Jordan during the next 30 to 60 days. The announcement coincided with the resignation of Jordan Prime Minister Wasfi Telli. This American official stressed, was nothing more than a coincidence.

Telli, who was under heavy pressure after the Israeli attack in November, was known to have planned to resign and stayed on only because of the events Nov. 13. King Hussein has asked Telli to form a new government.
